Updating Personal Information in UTShare

It is that time of year again! Please upload your syllabus files into Canvas. Give the system about an hour or so to sync up and you should be able to see the syllabus link on your faculty web profiles.

- Remember, you can post a draft syllabus now, and update it later! You can watermark it as a draft.

New State-Mandated Cloud Service Requirements

Beginning Jan. 1, 2022, cloud applications and services that create, store, process or transmit state agency data will require certification from the state. This change was enacted under Senate Bill 475. If you use a cloud application or service that requires a new contract or renewal, submit your paperwork early.
