# Supporting Our Students

# New Transfer Student Portal

Taking pride in our role in supporting transfer students achieve their goals, faculty are encouraged to share two new tools at the heart of The new Maverick Transfer Pathway:

#1: <u>Transferology</u> – transfer students create an account with Transferology, enter their current and completed courses, select their major, and easily see how their courses apply to UTA degree plans.

#2: Maverick Transfer Track - Maverick Transfer Track is a customized tool for future UTA students to see what credits will be needed to complete a degree at UTA. Students can run "What if" scenarios for multiple UTA degree plans to see the best fit for their academic endeavors.

An <u>FAQ page</u> that can help answer questions is now available. Students are encouraged to reach out to their advisors with any additional questions.

### Lockdown Browser and Cell Phone Cameras

Students without webcams can use their cell phone cameras for the Lockdown Browser Monitoring feature: for Android Phones; for iPhones. Students will need to download both the application on their phone and the driver for their computer (Mac or Windows). For best results, students should plug their phones into their computers with a USB cable.
