Call for Provost Faculty Fellow to lead UTA's APLU/USU grant-funded UTA & Partners DFW Talent Skills Project

The UTA & Partners DFW Talent Skills Project will support transfer students from UTA's three closest and largest community colleges to understand and acquire 21st century skillsets DFW employers seek in professional employees (The project will focus on key APLU/USU recognized 21st century skills: teamwork, technology application, professionalism, and career management.
