Provost's Seed Grant Competition

The Provost is pleased to announce the launch of a micro-grant program for awards. These five awards are to cover expenses up to \$2000 to individuals to help fund a new project that might include archive visits, equipment, travel to institutional or labs, etc. The research topic is open, but the award is intended to help faculty with research that could lead to a larger grant/research project. Proposals for these grants will be accepted from full-time faculty.

The research from these grants is expected to provide a foundation for a new project and/or subsequent large grant proposals to be submitted to government agencies or private/corporate foundations. The research project must be completed within 12 months of the award. Award recipients will be asked to present their work at a seminar event to be scheduled after the completion of the projects.
