New SFS Tool: SmartEvals

A streamlined and more sophisticated Student Feedback System, <u>SmartEvals</u>, is now available to all faculty. Please review these tips to improve response rates:

- Remind students that the <u>evaluation period</u> has begun and they'll receive daily emails which will allow them to complete the surveys. The survey period is 2 weeks before the end of the course (16 week) and one week for dynamic dated courses.
- Faculty can log into <u>MyEvalCenter</u> and click the "QR codes" link for their class(es). Print the page that is then displayed and distribute it to students. Using their mobile devices, students can scan the code and complete the evaluation right in class!
- Give students a few specific examples of how you used feedback from past course evaluations. For example: "Last semester the evaluations said I should make better use of the course website, and that is why this year I have been posting notes online."
- Remind students that their responses are completely anonymous, and that instructors will only see results after grades are released.
