Canvas and Course Syllabi

<u>Texas House Bill 2504</u> requires that syllabi, CV and other information must be made available to the public by the first day of classes. Videos and additional training resources are available <u>here</u>. Faculty can upload syllabi in Canvas and it will automatically upload to Digital Measures and their Mentis profile.

The Canvas upload is a one-stop shop and eliminates the need to upload in multiple places. In the Canvas course, on the left-hand side in the white gallery, faculty will find an "**upload syllabus**" label (second from the bottom).

The university syllabus template is formatted for accessibility. If faculty create their own syllabi, they will need to verify it for accessibility. Faculty are also reminded that any new version of the same course syllabus that was uploaded will override the previous version. All previous versions of the syllabus will be available under "**syllabus_upload**" folder in Canvas in case faculty need to reference a previous version.

Progress Report Grades in Canvas

Four- week grades or Progress Reports are required for <u>specific</u> <u>student groups</u> of students such as athletes and freshmen, and are <u>due</u> **Friday Sept. 20**. Faculty for all undergraduate courses are encouraged to use a syllabus quiz or <u>similar assignment</u> as a progress report to provide an early indication of student engagement. The progress report allows for faster intervention by the <u>Division of Student Success</u>. CDE's <u>training</u> page offers sessions on using the Canvas gradebook, and also offers <u>Canvas Open Lab Hours</u>.
