Final Grade Collection

Grade Rosters for Spring 2019 are now open for grade entry. The deadline to submit grades is Tuesday, **May 14, 2019 at 12:00 pm**.

To ensure we are compliant with U.S. Department of Education regulations, all UT Arlington faculty are required to include additional data when recording an "F" for a student's grade in MyMav. For additional information, see <u>Entering "F"</u> <u>Grades</u>. You may either enter your grades directly into MyMav or use Blackboard. For more information on entering grades, see <u>Entering Grades</u>. If you are entering grades directly into MyMav, be sure to set the grade roster status to "Approved" when you are finished entering grades.

Please ensure your grades are submitted in a timely fashion. Faculty that consistently fail to submit grades on time may be ineligible for merit pay, Faculty Development Leaves and other programs. Lists of faculty who do not meet the grades deadline will be sent to the Offices of the President, Provost, and to the Dean and Associate Dean(s) of your College/School.

Join the Canvas Revolution

Now is the time to sign up for Canvas training! Blackboard will be decomissioned at the start of Fall 2019 and we'll move to have all faculty in Canvas. Summer is the perfect time to migrate your course, and learn how to engage your students with this flexible and new LMS platform. Faculty have several options for training:

1. Ask your <u>College Champion</u> to enroll you in the self-paced online "Growing with Canvas" course.

 Attend face-to-face or online <u>training sessions</u>. More than 50 sessions were offered in April and at least 40 will be offered in May.

 Ask your department or college to organize a Canvas training just for you and your colleagues (minimum 20 people).

Canvas offers a number of accessibility tools for materials used in organized courses including font sizing, rich content editor and <u>ARC</u> (Canvas video tool) which allows for close captioning.
