#### **Mentoring Veterans**

UTA is proud of its longstanding partnership with American Corporate Partners (ACP), a national, nonprofit organization dedicated to helping military veterans and active-duty spouses transition to the private sector. Please consider being a mentor with ACP. Mentors and veteran protégés are paired by ACP based on a variety of considerations, including shared career interests, education level, and region. Mentors are asked to help veterans by offering guidance on résumé and interview preparation, career perspectives, and other topics of mutual interest. Both mentors and protégés are asked to commit to the relationship for a year and participate in a monthly networking session, often an hour-long, that may be conducted by phone, email, videoconference, and in some cases, in-person. Throughout the year, an ACP staff member checks in regularly to ensure satisfaction, provide resources and track the progress of the relationship.
