Canvas and Kaltura

Course content videos hosted in Kaltura and currently being migrated to Canvas' Studio (formerly ARC). The migration of over 6,000 videos is expected to be complete by October 18, 2019. Faculty are asked to **not create new course content in Kaltura** as of 9/30/2019. Please check the Announcement in your Canvas course homepage for <u>instructions</u> and <u>FAQs</u>. <u>Training sessions</u> are also available through CDE.

As of 9/23/19, there are 3,951 Fall courses published in Canvas including 3,703 non-AO and 248 Accelerated Online. In addition, the RN-BSN, MSN, and CONHI programs had 12 Courses (including electives), 22 sections of those courses, 22 faculty, 75 coaches, and 3900+ students now engaged in Canvas.
