Microsoft Authenticator Log-In

Beginning September 23, the University of Texas at Arlington will use Microsoft Authenticator to login to applications and systems. If you have been using MyMav, UTA email or Canvas on or off campus you have already set up Microsoft Authenticator and do not need to do anything. If you have not used the above systems you may need to install Microsoft Authenticator by using the steps found via Managing your devices through Microsoft Authenticator.

Faculty Development Leave

The Faculty Development Leave Program provides release time to tenured faculty members by providing a limited number of campus-wide awards through a competitive process. Faculty Development Leave proposals may be submitted by any member of the UT Arlington faculty who has served as full-time assistant, associate or full professor for at least two consecutive academic years at the time the proposal is submitted and has earned (or, for assistant professors, will have earned) tenure by the time the leave commences.
