UTA unveils MAVRC, boosting drone research and innovation

About 150 industry leaders, researchers from universities across Texas and community partners <u>gathered</u> on Sept. 16 as UTA unveiled the Maverick Autonomous Vehicle Research Center—<u>MAVRC</u>. Located at <u>UTARI</u>, the 120-by-150-foot structure towers 40 feet high and is equipped with 26 motion-capture cameras, wireless internet and nighttime lighting. A connected 720-square-foot control and observation center allows researchers, students and industry partners to test advanced autonomous aerial vehicles in a controlled, FAA-compliant environment. The grand opening event was covered by <u>WFAA</u>, <u>NBC 5</u>, <u>FOX 4</u>, <u>Telemundo</u>, <u>Fort Worth Report</u>, the <u>Dallas Business Journal</u>, <u>Hispanic Business TV</u>, <u>WBAP-AM</u>, <u>NewsBreak</u>, and <u>Drone Life</u>.



Regulatory Updates

NOT-OD-25-143: NIH Will Stop Posting Notices of Funding Opportunities in the NIH Guide for Grants and Contracts in FY2026

Starting in fiscal year 2026, NIH will post all funding opportunities exclusively on Grants.gov, ending their publication in the NIH Guide for Grants and Contracts. The Guide will still feature policy and informational notices, but applicants must now use Grants.gov to find and track funding announcements.


NOT-OD-25-155: New Application Structure for NIH-Funded International Collaborations

For grants requesting NIH funding for one or more foreign components, NIH will require that competing applications submit applications to a Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) that supports the new PF5 <u>Activity Code</u> for grants, new UF5 Activity Code for cooperative agreements, or another complex mechanism activity code that supports the International Project component type.

NOT-OD-25-154: Implementation of NIH Research Security Policies

In alignment with the CHIPS and Science Act of 2022 (P.L. 117-167), National Security Presidential Memorandum-33 (NSPM-33), and the July 29, 2024, Office of Science and Technology Policy (OSTP) memorandum on <u>Guidelines for Research Security Programs at Covered Institutions</u>, NIH is establishing a series of requirements to strengthen transparency and accountability across NIH funded projects.
