FACULTY MENTOR GUIDELINES

Full-time UTA faculty are eligible to serve as a mentor. Faculty mentors must sign bi-weekly timesheets.

Graduate students and post-docs may serve in a supervisory role, but a faculty member must provide direct mentoring.

The Office of Undergraduate Research considers students with little to no research experience to those students who have vast amounts of research experience. This competitive assistantship program may allow those with little experience to learn the fundamentals of research by assisting a faculty member on their research project(s). For students with more experience, students may join a faculty-led research team or consider independent research with a faculty mentor facilitating the process. This allows students to take ownership of part or all of their research project.
