Overall and Psychology GPA must be a 2.25 or higher to stay in the major, once you have completed PSYC 2300, 3300, and 3200 with a C or better in each course you will be changed to full major as long as you meet the GPA requirements.

Minor in Psychology

A minor consists of 18 hours of psychology course work.

General (preferred), Clinical Health, Neuroscience, or Organizational Science.

PSYC 1315 cannot be counted

towards the general emphasis for psych majors only

Research in Psychology

Students may complete research hours to count towards Psych Emphasis or as electives. The student must obtain permission from the professor and complete Permission Form. Research hours cannot be applied to the minor and only 6 hrs will count towards emphasis, additional hours will count as advanced electives.

Internship in Psychology

Students may complete internship hours to count towards Psych Emphasis or as electives. The student must meet required prerequisites: PSYC 2300, 3300, 3200, a minimum 3.20 psych GPA and relevant prereqs. Student must also obtain permission from the professor and complete the Internship Form.
