### **SOME HIGHLIGHTED RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Provide immediate in person or telephonic assessment of children identified in need of BH services; diagnose and develop treatment plans for full array of BH disorders and sub-clinical symptoms; provide treatment interventions and short-term counseling to children and families.
- Perform psychotherapeutic interventions, either in-person or via telemedicine as clinically indicated by the assessment and/or DSM diagnosis.
- Provide ongoing in person and telephonic support to children and families to assure treatment goals are met.
- Develop and facilitate professional education on behavioral and mental health issues
- Effectively communicate with referral sources keeping them up to date on treatment plans and progress and providing training as needed on identification of behavioral health issues.
- Schedule patient appointments
- Perform other duties, including administrative duties, critical incident stress interventions (CISM), and special projects as required.
