PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT (POE) APPLICATION

Option 2:

The student works at a social work agency, and their current role and responsibilities have clear linkages to the student's level of learning (BSW / MSW) and the 9 CSWE competencies. The student's place of employment can provide at least one new project or learning opportunity that is separate from the student's current role and responsibilities. Their place of employment will fulfill the following field education requirements:

- Activities align with the student's BSW or MSW learning contract.
- Activities align with student specialty if an Advanced MSW student: Aging, CAP, Children and Families, Health, or Mental Health/Substance Abuse.
- Provide the student with a qualified Field Instructor who will supervise the student and provide 1-hour weekly supervision.
- Be affiliated with UTA's School of Social Work.

Qualified Field Instructor Requirements:

- 1. The individual holds a BSW or MSW degree from a CSWE-accredited school and has two years of post-degree Social Work experience.
- 2. Individuals with a BSW can only supervise BSW students.
- 3. Individuals with an MSW can supervise BSW and MSW students.
- 4. The agency must provide a qualified field specialist.

Disclaimers:

All students opting into a POE option must complete the POE Form, which must be returned to the student's Field Education Specialist for review to determine whether the request should be approved or denied.

If the agency is not affiliated with UTA, the affiliation process must be completed before the start of the respective field semester. Otherwise, your POE request will be denied.

If you are separated from your placement of employment (voluntarily or involuntarily) during your internship, your field placement will be put on hold, and you must reapply for field for the following semester.

<u>Please note:</u> You may not completed POE option 2 for BSW and/or foundation and advanced placement.
