Why do I need a license?

- Can legally call yourself a "social worker"
- "Licensed or registered social workers provide a practice backed by a legal guarantee—that service will be safe, competent, ethical, and responsible." (ASWB, 2020, p.1)
- Significant advantage in job market
- Indicates knowledge and professionalism
- Potential stigma associated with not being licensed

Types of Licenses in Texas


Licenses

- LBSW
 - Licensed Baccalaureate Social Worker
- LMSW
 - Licensed Master Social Worker
- LCSW
 - Licensed Clinical Social Worker

Specialty Recognitions

- LBSW-IPR
 - (Independent Practice Recognition)
- LMSW-IPR
- LMSW-AP
- LCSW-S
 - (Supervisor)

Applying for LBSW

Application

- 1. <u>Application for licensure</u>
 - Must use new BHEC forms, not "old" forms (e.g. Form A, Form III)!
- 2. <u>Pay fee (\$109)</u>
 ➢ Online, check or money order
- 3. Official college transcript verifying BSW degree conferred from a CSWE accredited program
 - Can apply in your last semester- need <u>Dean's Letter</u>
 - Must submit official transcripts after graduation
- 4. Proof of completion of <u>Jurisprudence Exam</u>

≻ \$39

- > Online, untimed, open book, can't fail
- Completion certificate within 6 months of applying
- 5. Copy of valid photo ID with full legal name

Registering and Taking Test

- 1. (Wait several weeks for approval to take exam)
- 2. Once approved, <u>register for exam with ASWB (\$230)</u>
- 3. Sign up for exam at an approved <u>PearsonVue</u> testing center
 - Nearby testing centers may not have availability for a few weeks
 - > Can take ASWB exam in any state
- 4. ASWB sends score to the Board within 2 weeks
- 5. You receive license in the mail within 1 month+


ASWB Exam Format

- Computer-based
- Multiple Choice
- 4 hours to complete
- 170 Questions
 - 150 "real" questions
 - 20 being tested for validity
 - You will never know which 20

- Passing Score depends on which version of the test you get
- Range:
 - "Easiest"= Need 107 / 150 (71%)
 - "Hardest"= Need 93 / 150 (62%)

Level	Human Development, Diversity, & Behavior	Assessment	Interventions	Ethics
LBSW	25%	29%	26%	20%
LMSW	27%	24%	24%	25%
LCSW	24%	30%	27%	19%



What if I fail the exam?

- Exam attempt & fail 1
- Wait 90 days
- Exam attempt & fail 2
- Wait 90 days
- Exam attempt & fail 3
- Apply to board for subsequent exams
 - Submit plan to the board about how you will ensure success on future tests (form forthcoming)
 - No official limit, but board approves each request on case by case basis




No more AMEC (Alternative Method of Examining Competency) (no supervision alternative)

Applying for LMSW

Application

- 1. <u>Application for licensure</u>
- <u>Pay fee (\$109</u> for new, \$20 to upgrade from LBSW)
 > Online, check or money order
- 3. Official college transcript verifying MSW degree conferred from a CSWE accredited program
 - Can apply in your last semester- need <u>Dean's Letter</u>
 Must submit official transcripts after graduation
- 4. Proof of completion of <u>Jurisprudence Exam</u>

- > Online, untimed, open book, can't fail
- Completion certificate within 6 months of applying
- 5. Copy of valid photo ID with full legal name



Getting Started

- Must have LMSW
- Must be supervised by LCSW-S
 - Workplace or outside supervision
- Must submit <u>supervision plan</u> to your supervisor
 - Must update plan if switching employers/ supervisors



- On Sep 11, a motion was passed that "eliminates the current requirement that supervision plans be submitted and approved by TSBSWE. Instead, an LBSW or LMSW under supervision (working towards their IPR or LCSW) would simply need to turn the supervision plan in to his or her supervisor, who will retain the form and submit it to BHEC after the requirements have been completed, along with the verification form. As soon as the supervisor has that form, supervision can officially begin, rather than the person waiting on board approval. "-NASW TX
- This applies to LBSW-IPR and LMSW-IPR supervision plans too

LCSW

What you need

- Over the course of 24-48 months post-MSW:
 - 3,000 hours of social work experience (30 hrs/week, 50 weeks a year)
 - 100 hours of supervision from a board approved LCSW-S (at least 8 must be individual)
 - At least 4 hours/week must be clinical, plus 26 hrs/week of other social work duties
 - Clinical= assessing, diagnosing and treatment mental illness

LCSW

After Finishing Hours & Supervision

- Submit to the board:
 - <u>Application</u> (\$129)*
 - Copy of Driver's License
 - Official transcripts
 - Certificate of completion for passing <u>Jurisprudence Exam</u> (\$39)
 - Application to upgrade license (\$20)
 - <u>Clinical Supervision Verification</u>
 <u>Form</u>

(Wait several weeks for approval to take exam)*

- Once Board approves, register with ASWB (phone or online)
 - **\$260** exam fee
- Sign up at approved (PearsonVue) testing center
- May have to wait a few weeks for local testing site availability
- ASWB sends score to the Board within 2 weeks
- You receive license in the mail within 1 month

Practice Recognitions

LBSW-IPR and LMSW-IPR

- Must have "base" license
- Similar <u>supervision process</u> as LCSW, but work is non-clinical
 24-60 months to complete
- May work under contract, bill directly for services, and bill third parties for reimbursements for *non-clinical* services
- Retake Jurisprudence Exam

LCSW-S*

- 2 years full time post LCSW licensure practice experience
- 40-hour training course from boardapproved provider
- Additional CEU requirements (3 hours per renewal period on supervision)
- *LBSW-S and LMSW-S are also offered, but this is much less common

Temporary Licenses

- Mostly commonly used for recent graduates who have a job that requires a license.
- Only offered for <u>LBSW</u> and <u>LMSW</u>
- To qualify:
 - You must have a **current application on file** for licensure as an LBSW

AND

• You must never have taken the ASWB examination for LBSW

LCSW	MSW	Clinical	3,000 hours post LMSW	100 hours
LCSW-S	MSW	None	-Minimum 2 years post LCSW -40 hours of training	None

Criminal History

- What if I have a record? Can I still get a license?
 - Criminal history disclosure on licensing application
- Criminal History evaluation
 - \$50
 - Board reviews background and provides a statement as to whether the history would preclude licensure upon graduation
 - Complete *before* pursuing degree!



Texas does not have official reciprocity

<u>/lilitary Exception</u>

License Reciprocity

Endorsement is determined on a case-by-case basis.

Verification of Licensure in Au District

Renewing license every 2 years

- \$163 for LCSW

- 30 hours in 2-year period
- 6 must be ethics
- 1 in <u>human trafficking prevention</u>- free SOAR course
