NOTES:

This is the standard list of all classes in this program of study. It is not necessarily the order in which to take courses. Please see your Academic Advisor to develop your individualized program of study.

REQUIRED:

Introductory Practice Courses: must take BOTH; SOCW 5332 may only be taken concurrently with 5311 or after completing 5311.

Integrated Theory and Practice Courses: must take any TWO from the six listed. Must take concurrently with 5311 or after completing 5311.

Research Course: must choose ONE of the two courses listed.

Advanced Field Placement: Students are required to complete SOCW 5311 and SOCW 5332 before taking advanced field. A 3.0 cumulative GPA is required to take advanced field. May take SOCW 5482 then SOCW 5483 in consecutive semesters (SPLIT) or take both SOCW 5485 and SOCW 5486 as a BLOCK in one semester.

Capstone Course Options: Students must choose to take the Integrative Seminar or Thesis Option.

<u>Integrative Seminar</u> – This option must be taken in the final program semester concurrently with 5483 or after completing block of SOCW 5485 & SOCW 5486.

<u>Thesis Option</u> – This option may be taken in place of one elective AND the Integrative Seminar.

ELECTIVES:

Students with Advanced Standing must take 3 social work electives, while students without Advanced Standing must take 2 social work electives to complete their program of study and the number of required credit hours to graduate. The suggested electives above are those that the faculty STRONGLY recommend as supporting your development in this area of specialization. However, other electives may be considered. Any elective must be chosen from the advanced level social work courses offered (check for any applicable prerequisites).

CERTIFICATES:

Students may choose to add a graduate certificate to their program of study. Certificate requirements vary, but require an additional 6-12 hours of coursework. DP Aging students may select one of five certificate options to add to their MSW degree. These include: the Military Social Work Certificate, Certificate in Administrative Leadership, Certificate in Policy Leadership, Certificate in Community Leadership, and the Certificate in Organizational Leadership.
