African American Pioneer of the Week: Mary Church Terrell

Mary Church Terrell (1863-1954) was a true pioneer for African American women. As the daughter of former slaves-turned-small-businessowners, she was one of the first Black women to earn a bachelor's degree, the first black woman appointed to a school board, and the first African American admitted to the Washington DC Branch of the American Association of University Women.


