

MAVS EDGE PROGRAM PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT
THE LOCKHEED MARTIN CAREER DEVELOPMENT CENTER AND _____

This internship partnership agreement between The University of Texas at Arlington, on behalf of its Lockheed Martin Career Development Center (University) and _____ (Partnering Organization) indicates a voluntary agreement to participate in the *Mavs EDGE* Dedicated Internship Program, an experiential learning program provided by The University of Texas at Arlington, Lockheed Martin Career Development Center.

- I. Overall Project Goals, Services and Outcomes:** The *Mavs EDGE* Program is a dedicated internship program through which Lockheed Martin Career Development Center employer partners receive specialized program services in return for dedicated opportunities for The University of Texas at Arlington’s students and alumni.
- II. Term and Termination:** This agreement will be in effect for an initial period of one year and will continue from year to year unless one party gives the other thirty (30) days’ notice of intent to terminate. If such notice is given, this agreement will terminate at the end of such thirty (30) days.
- III. University Obligations:** The Lockheed Martin Career Development Center will provide the following services in specific support of this project:
 - a) *Registration fee discounts for select internship programming events.*
 - b) *Elevated marketing and position promotion opportunities through UTA marketing outlets.*
 - c) *Connection with UTA Internship Coordinators departmental contacts.*
 - d) *Access to tailored internship materials / resources / workshops.*
 - e) *Participation in workforce skills curriculum development through membership in a corporate forum.*
 - f) *A Preliminary Needs Assessment, to include identification of the current workforce needs and/or challenges and creation of key performance indicators for the position.*
 - g) *Internship Position Description Development – assist with creation and/or review of position responsibilities and learning objectives related to the internship position.*
- IV. Partnering Organization Obligations/Acknowledgements:** The partnering organization will provide the following services in specific support of this project:
 - a) *Recruit, interview, and provide placement consideration for one or more UTA student(s) in an internship experience(s) during the Spring, Summer, and Fall of the 2020-2021 academic calendar.*
 - b) *Participate in on campus brand building and student engagement opportunities.*
 - c) *Conduct candidate interviews and make final selections for internship offers.*
 - d) *Report student hiring or placement information to the Lockheed Martin Career Development Center.*
 - e) *Participate in program promotion and branding by developing a student "spotlight" to be shared via UTA marketing - includes the sharing of your company logo.*
 - f) *Participation in the program does not guarantee student placement.*
- V. Governing Law:** This agreement and the interpretation of its terms and conditions shall be governed by the laws of the State of Texas.
