SHORT SHOTS FILM FESTIVAL

- Short film submissions must be **four (4) minutes or less**
 - If using copyrighted music, you must use 60 seconds or less of total copyrighted music for the films to be displayed on YouTube.

We plan to upload them for future reference so please adhere to this.

If you have access to the internet you have access to loads of copyright-free or royal-free music! Take this time to try your hand at creating your own musical masterpieces or even looking to a talented friend; this event is meant to shed light on the creativity of UTA students!

- Submissions should be tasteful; **no nudity, offensive language, images or messages.**
- o The Short Shots Film Festival Committee will have the ultimate decision as to what will be shown at the screening. Factors such as a poor message or too many video submissions may result in your video submissions not being shown during the screening.
- Submissions should be submitted via google forms.
- Filmmakers are encouraged to use any equipment available to you;
 - o Cellphones, Cameras, Professional and amateur filming equipment, etc.

EXCEL will not provide filming equipment or materials of any sort.

- Deadline for submissions is Wednesday, April 20 by 5:00pm.
- Contestants will compete for awards for the following categories:
 - 1. Best Film Score (Music)
 - 2. Best Documentary
 - 3. Best Screen Play
 - 4. Best Actor/Actress
 - 5. Best Cinematography
 - 6. People's Choice
 - 7. Best in Show
- Following the film festival all short films will be displayed in the UC, social media, and on the EXCEL YouTube channel.

Helpful information for filmmakers:

- Editing is easier when done on a computer rather than a phone by using programs such as Windows Moviemaker or Apple's iMovie
- Storyboarding and planning before shooting your footage can ensure a more effective and efficient filmmaking process
- Using a voice recorder for voiceovers is a good alternative to alleviate potential distracting background noise in the video's audio
- Make sure you have enough time to edit or reshoot footage before submission date!
