

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT**

This First Amendment to Interlocal Agreement between **Dallas Independent School District** ("District"), a local political subdivision of the State of Texas, and **The University of Texas at Arlington**, a Texas institution of higher education (referred to herein as "**UTA**") on behalf of its **College of Architecture, Planning and Public Affairs** (referred to herein as "**CAPPA**"), is made and entered into effective on the date of execution by the District.

**RECITALS**

**Whereas**, the District and UTA made and entered into an Interlocal Agreement as of July 1, 2020 for a pilot program to collaborate on a dual credit course program on behalf of City Lab High School (the "Agreement"); and

**Whereas**, District and UTA desire to renew the Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the agreement made, the Parties agree to the following:

1. The Agreement is hereby renewed for an additional one-year term from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022 ("Renewal Term").

All other terms and conditions, including any and all attachments and documents stemming from the Interlocal Agreement, shall remain in full force and effect.
