Q1 What is TSI?

TSI (Texas Success Initiative) is a state law that requires all undergraduate, degree-seeking students at Texas public colleges to show college-level readiness in English and Math.

Q2 Where can I view my TSI status after admission to UTA?

After admission to UTA, you can view your TSI status in MyMav (click the Admissions tile, then TSI status). Your TSI Overall Status will be listed, see Q3 below for TSI status definitions. If your TSI status is Liable or Not Complete, "No" will be indicated next to the subject area(s) if TSI hasn't been met.

Q5 What if I do not have exemptions for one or more areas of TSI?

You must take the relevant sections of the TSI Assessment test (English and/or Math based on your TSI Liable status) prior to enrollment at UTA.

Q6 When should I take the TSI Assessment test?

It is recommended that TSI testing is completed as soon as possible.

Q7 How/where can I take the TSI Assessment test?

UTA <u>Academic Testing Services</u> offers the TSI Assessment test in person, online, and remotely (student tests at non-UTA testing location). You can also contact your local Texas community college or high school for TSI testing availability.

Q8 What are the TSI Assessment test passing scores to be classified as TSI Complete?

TSIA2 (test date on or after January 11, 2021 - scores must be less than 5 years old)

Q9 I have previously taken the TSI Assessment test at another Texas school - can my scores be used?

If your scores are less than 5 years old, then they can be used to update your TSI status. Contact UTA <u>Academic Testing</u> <u>Services</u> at <u>assessment@uta.edu</u> to request your TSI scores to be posted to your MyMav account.

Q10 I have taken the TSI Assessment test and my TSI status is Not Complete, what are my next steps?

The TSI Coordinator will contact you via your MyMav student email with your required next steps prior to your attendance at New Maverick Orientation.
